<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • I think some of the homeworks could be a little shorter because they are a lot of work for not that many points compared to other assignments. • The quizzes could be improved. They were often hard to read, and the in-class ones went by too fast and you couldn't go back and check your answers. Wording could often be confusing as well. I do not feel like the quizzes helped me, they mainly served as an extra stress • I believe that using R studio and coding was not really closely connected to the concept that we learned from text book. It feels to be more like separated, making me to work twice. • I think just having assignments due at noon is a bit strange. Sometimes, it's a bit hard to remember that I have something due at that time. • Basecamp. • The data camps at times didn't see applicable to any of the homework we were doing, but I understand that the practice is important! • Having the final project and paper analysis be due within two days of each other created an intense crunch at the end of the class and I wish the course was paced better. • the homework should be more focused on the statistics part not the coding • Having both paper analysis and final project seems like a bit much, the practice may have been unnecessary. • I wish the the lectures and the textbook didn't cover the material in the same way. I wish the lectures could give a different perspective or additional context on the textbook's work, as sometimes people wouldn't understand the textbook. When the lecture was explained the same way as the textbook, they didn't understand it any better the second time. • I think that the reading quizzes could be improved. In the first few weeks, I would thoroughly read through the chapter and take notes but the reading quizzes were incredibly difficult and unrelated. The two in class reading quizzes were much easier and made sense for the difficulty of the reading.
